Skills & Knowledge: Effective communication Ability to treat all participants with respect and dignity Willingness to work as a team Ability to comply with established standards of ethics and confidentiality Knowledge of the signs of substance use disorders, mental health disorders, & co-occurring disorders Ability to work with participants who may display behavioral health issues

High School Diploma or GED Certified as a Peer Recovery Specialist, or willingness to obtain within 1 year of employment First Aid and CPR certified, or obtain within 1 month of hire Candidates with lived experience in mental health and/or addictions are encouraged to apply. Applicants required to have at least 2 years of long-term recovery/stability
