Residents receive services that promote stabilization, acquisition of life skills, referrals to needed resources, and ultimately discharge to permanent housing. <u>POSITION OVERVIEW</u>: The Program Manager is responsible for the day to day operation of the Safe Haven. This includes, but is not limited to the following; supervision of staff, work schedule, menu planning, acquisition of supplies, oversight of meal prep, ensuring staff are making appropriate referrals to outside agencies and services, oversight and maintenance of resident files, required reporting internally and to funding sources, attendance at meetings and seminars as relate to position, reporting maintenance concerns, and other duties as assigned. The guiding principle is that everyone is treated with respect and dignity, and staff serve as role models, mentors, advocates and motivators for participants in order to promote stabilization and personal growth. This is a full-time position, where some evening and weekend work is occasionally required. Reports to the Executive Director.
