How long will the learning collaborative and individual consultation process take? What is the timeframe for this?

Dr. Archibald will meet with organizations and set an individual timeframe based on its specific needs and capacity, accommodating each organization's schedules to the extent possible. The full learning collaborative will run from January 2022 to June 2022.

Is this a competitive process? How is it decided who will participate?

There is rating criteria listed at the end of the RFP beginning on page 11 will be used to score letters of interest. The process is competitive in that the highest-scored organizations will be invited to participate. However, the goal is to have as much participation as possible given capacity and resources, and so we are not looking to exclude organizations from participation. Up to seven organizations can be selected for this round of the learning collaborative.

Additionally, there are no specific staffing requirements tied to this procurement; however, it is strongly recommended that each selected participant organize a team of staff to participate in the learning collaborative. Each team should include 3-5 people from various levels in the organization. The strongest teams will have at least one person who has a position of leadership to ensure that changes can be implemented and sustained.
