RESPITE CARE PROGRAM

WHAT IS RESPITE CARE?

The Children's Choice Respite Program serves as a bridge for individuals and their families who are in need of temporary relief from the stress of caring for a child with special mental health or behavioral needs often as a result of trauma exposure.

WHAT IT LOOKS LIKE

In-home respite

Ranges from 1 to 10 hours during the day.

Out-of-home respite

Ranges from 1 to 12 nights every 3 months, depending on the needs of the parent(s) and child.

WHY IT IS NEEDED

This interval of rest will enable parents/caregivers to refuel, replenish, restore their energy and resources to serve children with special needs.
